1. Dancer's name, grade in the fall and years of dance experience.
2. Why do you want to do a solo?
3. What do you expect to gain from doing a solo?
4. What are your top 3 dance strengths?
5. What are your top 3 dance weaknesses?
6. What is your strongest dance style? Why?
7. If you could choose your solo dance style, what would you choose?
8. If you could choose your solo teacher, who would you choose?
9. Parent's signature and date.
10. Student's signature and date.

Solo Guidelines:

- Dancers must be a member of the Xcel Program for 1 year before becoming eligible to apply for the Solo Program.
- Dancers must be a member of the Xcel Program and in at least 1 dance during the dance season they are in the Solo Program.
- Any dancers that are eligible for the Solo Program and are interested should fill out an application. Dancers and parents must understand that the faculty will take your information into consideration when placing dancers in the Solo Program. However, when placing dancers the following things are considered: a) What style we think the dancer has the most experience in and will look the best doing. b) How many Solo openings are available. c) Dancers previous class attendance, attitude and work ethic.
- **DISCLAIMER:** The Fuzion faculty cannot guarantee that all dancers will be placed in the Solo Program.

Attendance Expectations: Fuzion dancers who choose to be a part of our competition programs need to understand that attendance in all classes CRUCIAL for success. The faculty strongly feels that school should be a dancers #1 priority. Dancers who choose to be in competition are choosing this as their extracurricular activity and it should come first before ALL other activities.
